Joseph Matt. 2:13-15 **Angel** (2 years later)

What was Joseph told by the angel in a dream? v.13
What does he do? vv.14-15

Joseph Matt. 2:19-23 **Angel** (5 years later)

What was Joseph told by the angel in a dream? v.19-20
What did he do? vv.21-23

Jesus Matthew 4:1-11 **Angels** (20+ years later)

When does Satan come to tempt Jesus? vv.2-3
What does he want Jesus to do? vv.4-16
Why do angels come? v.11

Jesus Luke 22:39-44 **Angels** (3 years later)

Where was Jesus? v.39
What did He ask the Father? v.42
Why did the angel come? v.43

Mary Magdalene & other Mary Matt. 28:1-8 **Angel** (3 days later)

Where did they go? v.1
What did an angel do? v.2
What did he look like? v.3
What did he say? vv.5-7
What did the women do? v.8

Mary Magdalene John 20:10 **2 angels**

Where is she? v.11
What does she see? v.12
What do they ask?
Then who does she see? v. 14
