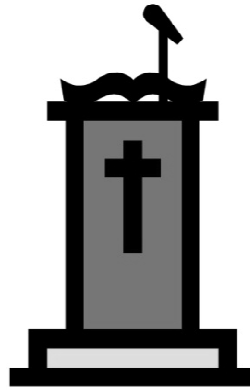

### Nick and Rebekah Ecker: Chile

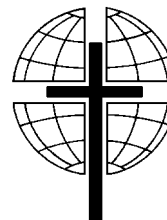
